Room to Care

Building a Community, a Neighbourhood, a Home

Where do loved ones go when they can no longer look after themselves at home? They look for a home that will offer them privacy, freedom and choice while caring for their physical, psychological, emotional and spiritual needs. A place that helps them to hold on to their dignity. A place to call home!

Providence Care Centre, opening in 2015, will become home to 160 residents who are no longer able or safe to look after themselves.

Each resident will have a private room with a wheelchair accessible bathroom and shower. Residents are encouraged to bring in pictures and personal possessions to make it feel like their home.

Knowing that social connectedness improves physical and mental health, the resident rooms will be placed in clusters – or small “neighbourhoods” – within the Centre. There will be two neighbourhoods per floor each with their own dining room and lounge area.

Resident Rooms – Studios

Of the 160 resident rooms in the Providence Care Centre:

- 120 rooms will be for those requiring ‘Supportive Living – Level 4’ – residents with stable or predictable health needs who seek independence and the comfort of knowing required personal care is on site when needed.
- 30 rooms will be for the provision of “Long Term Care” – for those with complex unpredictable medical needs who require continuous access to a Registered Nurse.
- 10 rooms have been funded in partnership with the Roman Catholic Diocese of Calgary and made available to retired Priests and other clergy.

Opportunity for Donor Recognition

Each of the Resident Rooms are single rooms (studios) and will include a kitchenette, microwave, refrigerator and a barrier-free three-piece bathroom.
